## Ground Transportation

Three airports service the Washington metropolitan area. The closest is Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport (DCA), approximately 6 miles from downtown Washington and both conference hotels.

### ● Shuttle

NACo has an agreement with Super Shuttle which provides the discounted rates below:

\$66.00 (roundtrip)

SuperShuttle's door-to-door service is available at all airports. Shuttles operate on a shared ride-on demand basis.

### ● Metrorail (subway)

Hotels are Metro accessible only from Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport (DCA). For the Washington Hilton, DuPont Circle Metro station on the Red Line is the closet metro station. Exit at the North end of the station and walk four blocks north on Connecticut Ave. to the hotel located at 1919 Connecticut Avenue. The Omni Shoreham Hotel is located one block
